#### Hello,

Although the qualifying problem is not due for two days, I have included two video clips related to the State Bowl topic as they are more likely to be useable as you prepare for the State Bowl competition. Results of the qualifying problem and State Bowl qualifying teams and individuals for both GIPS and scenario performance will be announced later this month.

This year, the winner in each division of the scenario writing competition will be invited to be part of the Washington State team that travels to Amherst, Massachusetts in June.

As you approach the topic of a Throw-Away Society, you may find that there are a number of similarities to e-Waste. Consider all aspects of a throw-away society, especially as it relates to the various categories. Think about how you define a throw-away society and then try to envision how to identify the long-term effects of this issue. Is the problem of plastic in the oceans an effect that can be resolved quickly or is it a very long-term problem? Is consumerism the root cause of our throw-away society or is the purely a capitalistic one? Can we change from a linear economy to a circular economy? Do we really understand where our garbage actually goes and what is its effect on the Earth?

## GIPS QP RULES REMINDER

Qualifying Problem due date: February 2. As the Qualifying Problem is not a practice problem, please adhere to the following rules regarding administration of the process:

- ✓ A team must be 4 or fewer students.
- ✓ A maximum of <u>120 consecutive minutes</u> are allowed to work on the booklet.
- ✓ Students must not see the Future Scene before the 120 minutes begin. Coaches should not read the Future Scene prior to the competition starting.
- ✓ They must use the scene for their division (Junior, Middle/Senior.)
- ✓ Work must be completed by the team only, with no outside help or resources of any kind.
- ✓ No notebook paper; however, blank white paper can be provided by the coach/proctor.
- ✓ Permitted items: Pencils, pencil sharpener, pens, highlighters, dictionary, thesaurus, pack of unopened sticky notes, calculator (non-programmable), and water.

Participants should adhere to all competition rules during the Qualifying Problem as if it were the State Bowl. Not only does this help with preparing for the State Bowl competition but also creates a fair environment for all competitors. ### SCENARIO PERFORMANCE SUBMISSIONS


Scenario Performances are due on February 6. Please remember to give viewing permission when you submit the Scenario Performance for evaluation.

Please submit the <u>ScP Submission Sheet</u> (found on the WAFPS website) to your coach's Dropbox at the same time that you submit your Scenario Performance link. If you have any questions, please email our Evaluation Director, Ann Foreyt, or our Affiliate Director, John Buissink.

#### Checklist:

- 1. Are you sure that your work shows a recognizable relationship to one of the topics for this current FPS year?
- 2. Is your work within the allowed time limit (up to 5 minutes)?
- 3. Have you presented your work in the correct format? (Performance must be in one continuous take.)

Did you label the video file as directed by the Evaluation Director or provide the YouTube link (marked **unlisted**)? If a YouTube video is submitted as either Private or Public, the evaluator will not be able to access it.

If your team/(or individual) qualifies for the 2023 State Bowl, your coach will receive a congratulations email with more information!

Deadline to register is March 6. The Medical Release form and the Publication Release/Statement of Authenticity must be uploaded to the Coach's dropbox no later than March 10. Both forms can be found on the WAFPS website under Events/State Bowl.

Note: This year, the High Ropes course will <u>not</u> be available at Warm Beach during the State Bowl. We are currently waiting to know if the Climbing Wall will or will not be available.

## 2023 STATE BOWL FEES

State Bowl 2023 will be held at Warm Beach Conference Center in Stanwood on March 22-24.

State Bowl Registration costs are as follows:

**Participant Resident**: \$84 registration plus \$143\* room & board, includes 2 nights, 5 meals. Total: \$227

**Participant Commuter:** \$84 registration plus \$59, includes 5 meals. Total: \$143

**Participant Thursday Only:** \$84 registration plus \$40, includes 1 meal and Warm Beach facility fee. Total \$124

**Adult Non-Coach:** \$25 registration plus \$143\* room & board, includes 2 nights, 5 meals. Total: \$168

**Adult Non-Coach Commuter:** \$25 registration plus \$59, includes 5 meals. Total: \$84

**Adult Thursday Visitor:** \$40 includes registration, Warm Beach facility fee, and one meal. One additional meal may be purchased at Warm Beach.

**Coach:** \$143\* room & board, includes 2 nights, 5 meals. Total \$143. Volunteer assignment information to follow for coaches.
